Foreword

Welcome to Raincliff

All the team here at Raincliff Station would like to welcome you to our on-farm Elk/Wapiti bull Sale. We are very pleased with the continuous improvements to the stock we present to the commercial deer farmer who wants to capitalise on using a good all round terminal sire. We are particularly pleased with the way these animals have come through for this sale line up for January 2024, when we take into account the challenging long wet winter these animals had after weaning and given that there paddocks were washed out during the floods 2021.

The continuous strive for improvement in our genetics that we are achieving is resulting in what I call the ideal terminal venison sire. In doing so, we are producing good solid animals with good bone structure, condition, temperament, doing ability and easily moved from here to their new farm environment.

The weight gain is what a commercial venison finisher is looking for to match the growth to meeting supply to the chilled venison market. With the current market programmes form Mountain River using branded elk venison into selected customers around the world, giving us confidence to keep doing what we do. This is very exciting for us as Elk/Wapiti breeders as this will encourage (with good planning) to achieve greater returns from venison per hectare.

This is a great incentive to use Elk Terminal Sires to supply these niche markets. I encourage you to talk to Mountain River Processors which should give you confidence in using these great animals as a terminal sire.

I am a great believer in being market led. New Zealand farmed raised venison leads the way in this concept, but it will need continuous discipline between the marketers, processors and the farmer going forward if we are to improve on the current returns. I would encourage farmers to supply to the processors that are using the Cervena Brand. This is now a well-known brand in the market place, and is trusted by the end users.

This year we have what I would call a more Wapiti type animal. These animals have had no special treatment, very much in their working clothes. They will suit a buyer who does not want the bigger elk but an animal with more Euro Red genetics in them.

These stags are of good sound structure, good bone and well fleshed throughout carcass. They are nice and quiet, and we are impressed with their weaning weights and spring growth rates.

As a family we would like to mention the retirement this year of two deer stock agents from

PGG Wrightson, Graham Kinsman and Ron Schroeder. These two have been great support to us here at Raincliff and we wish them all the best for their futures. We welcome Luke Thompson to the deer industry and look forward to your involvement

We would like to take this opportunity to thank family, friends, past and current staff for their continued support throughout the last twelve months. Growth Rates

You will notice we have put growth rates from birth, we do not tag or weigh at this time. We have put a normal birth weight in at 15kg and a nominal average birth date of 8th December. I would like to think this is a fair average.

Weights

We weaned this year's crop of Sale Stags early March 2021 and weighed, which is quite early for us. The next weigh was in October 2021 and then in December 2021. This gives us a good indication of their spring growth rate, turning grass into carcass weight. We are very pleased with the performance of this crop of yearlings at this stage.

We have continued to eye muscle scan all the yearling stock giving us another tool for selection criteria. We have also D.N.A all Elk/Wapiti stock on the farm to help improve future breeding decision, ass to that you will notice we have done an Elk% for all Bulls for sale, which is run through Genometer and Genomnz Invermay.
